




#### **AREAWIDE FUND - ACTUAL EXPENDITURE HISTORY**


#### **Actual Expenditure VS Actual Revenue History**









by major categories





#### **Mat-Su Borough Population Growth**




#### **ANNUAL ASSESSED VALUE**




#### ASSESSED VALUE CHANGE VS. POPULATION CHANGE
