RIGHT-OF-WAY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

In accordance with MSB 43.20.100, reserved or dedicated rights-of-way are required to be dedicated to the public. For the purposes of managing the public rights-of-way it is necessary that a dedication to the public be free and clear of other interests that the Borough has no control over. Easements controlled by a third party can interfere or prevent the Borough from managing said public rights-of-way for their intended purpose and in the best interest of the public. Developers are not to encumber proposed rights-of-way by utility easements or other interests. Encumbrance of a proposed right-of-way will result in disapproval of the proposed subdivision.
