
Loading Imagery Services in ArcMap

3. In ArcCatalog, double click Add ArcGIS Server.




4. In the Add ArcGIS Server window, select Use GIS services, then click Next.

 In ArcCatalog, under GIS Servers, there is now a new connection called imagery on maps.matsugov.us (user). Click on the plus signs to show the available data. Click once and hold, on the dataset of interest then drag and drop it into the map or Table of Contents.
