Port MacKenzie Business Development Strategic Action Plan: Accompanying this memo is a report from the International Association of Maritime and Port Executives, a not-for-profit industry association that conducts ongoing research regarding port management and development issues and provides management advisory services. MSB engaged with IAMPE to undertake a Strategic Action Plan for Business Development for Port MacKenzie. This report provides a market analysis, discusses governance, examines port development scenarios, and provides recommendations for consideration. This report will be utilized to facilitate a discussion with the Assembly in January 2022 regarding where to go with Port business development efforts and the funding appropriated for business development efforts.

Animal Care Shelter Operations: The Animal Shelter is changing the days they are open to the public effective December 1, 2021. Currently the Shelter is closed to the public on Sundays and Mondays; the new schedule will close the Shelter to the public on Mondays and Thursdays. This will provide greater community access on the weekends, and allow for an improved internal cleaning and sanitizing schedule. We will track our adoption numbers to see if the increased weekend access correlates with increased adoption rates and decreased shelter stay times.


