## **Windstorm Disaster Assistance Summary:**

Individual Assistance: 796 claims reported to the State with 165 claims reported through the Borough for a total of 961 claims.


Public assistance: there are currently 46 claims for damage to public infrastructure with the vast majority related to building or equipment damage.

Thus far, there have been 67 reports to the Borough from businesses regarding damage to commercial infrastructure with 14 of those reports categorized as major damage.

<u>Quarterly Wetland Mitigation Bank Report</u>: Sustainable Environments Group reports there were no credit sales this past quarter.

# **Quarterly Investments Summary (10/1/2021-12/31/2021):**

- Total return for the last quarter was 0.06% with interest received of \$481,688.
- Average market value for our portfolio was \$256,680,278.
- Weighted average to maturity for non-callable bonds is 3.08 years and for callable bonds is 1.92 years.
