This new system will provide alerts related to significant law enforcement activity in an area, evacuation information, missing person bulletins, suspect information, and other timely alerts.

<u>OR 22-074, Land Classification</u>: The following is offered for clarification regarding the land classification discussed at the June 21, 2022 Assembly meeting. As stated in the best interest findings, the overall parcel is 540 acres and is estimated to have approximately 3 million cubic yards of gravel. Only 51 acres is proposed to be developed through material extraction. The remaining 489 acres will remain as watershed. This leaves approximately 1.7 million cubic yards of clean gravel within the 51 reclassified acres, excluding wetland buffers.
