Jonesville Public Use Area Site Visit with DNR Commissioner: On August 15, the Mayor, Manager, and Borough staff met with and toured the Jonesville Public Use Area with the Alaska Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Commissioner, Alaska Department of Fish and Game Commissioner and staff. The discussion centered around a management agreement between the DNR and the Borough to advance improvements for the area. DNR is anticipating an updated management plan that would enable a management agreement by June 2023.
