RE: Manager's Weekly Post

<u>Tax Relief Update</u>: Our largest batch of refund checks from the rebate was processed this week. This batch consisted of 7,935 checks for a total of \$1,592,559. We are working through getting checks mailed out in the next couple of weeks.

We have processed several smaller manual refund batches over the last few weeks, so it is possible some taxpayers have already received a check. Another batch of 675 checks for a total of \$109,284 is being processed. The remaining refunds that are not able to be included in the bulk batches will be processed manually over the next several weeks.

<u>Public Outreach Mailings</u>: All mailings to taxpayers from the Borough utilize the mailing addresses maintained in the assessment records. These addresses originate from recorded documents received from the State of Alaska as property is bought or sold. For the most part these addresses are accurate but, on occasion, we find that the recorded document shows the property owners address as their former mailing address as it was correct at time of closing or even a street address for the new property. Additionally, the street address may not be a valid mailing address. In these instances, we update based upon Postal Service forwarding information, if it is present, or we wait for the property owner to provide updated mailing information.

Annually, we place notifications in the Frontiersman and on the Borough-website for property owners to contact us if they do not receive a property tax bill in July. Many property owners contact us if they do not receive a tax bill. We also research State records/databases, such as PFD routinely when tax mailings are returned or if the property goes into the foreclosure process.

<u>Grants Update</u>: Staff continue to explore opportunities for various grant opportunities. During fiscal years 2021, 2022, and the current fiscal year through October 2022, the Borough has received over \$82.8 million in grants with match funding totaling \$34.8 million. Based on these numbers, the Borough has more than tripled resources from these opportunities. A significant portion of this grant funding is American Rescue Plan Act funding and State match funding for transportation. When removing these large appropriations, although the number is smaller the ratio of the grant to the local match is fourfold. In other words, the Borough is receiving over four times the funding when compared to the required match funding (approximately \$20 million in grant funding for \$5 million in match).
