<u>Fish Passage Program Summary</u>: The fish passage program has replaced nine (9) fish passage barriers on anadromous creeks and streams throughout the Mat-Su Borough since 2020. Two were replaced in 2024 on Crocker Creek at Settler's Bay Drive and a Meadow Creek tributary along West Lakes Boulevard. More detailed information is provided in the attachments below.

<u>Online Land Sales</u>: The Land and Resource Management (LRM) Division will offer two Borough-owned land sales this fall. Public Surplus is the online platform that will be used for the competitive auctions. The first land sales will be for tax-foreclosed properties. The online catalog of those properties will be available for public viewing beginning September 30, 2024. Online bidding will be from October 14 through noon (12 p.m.) on October 29. Payment will include a 5% buyer's premium, and the winning bid needs to be paid by 5 p.m. on November 5. The online catalog, Public Surplus links, and more will be available at www.matsugov.us/landsales as we are nearing the sale.

After the tax-foreclosed auction, the LRM Division will open a Competitive Borough Land sales auction on November 4, 2024. Online bidding will start on November 18, and the auction will close on December 3 at noon (12 p.m.). The brochure will be available on our website and the Public Surplus website starting November 4, 2024. Borough financing is available for these parcels, and the winning bidder must close within 30 days.


