<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The subject parcels are located within the Talkeetna Community Council. The proposed subdivision is heard under MSB 43.15.025, *Abbreviated Plats* and MSB 43.15.054(G), *Exemptions*. Elimination of common lot lines are exempt from survey and monumentation requirements and allows the surveyor to use record information from the prior plat.

COMMENTS:

There were no objections or concerns received from Borough departments, outside agencies or the public at the time of this staff report.

CONCLUSION

The plat of Talkeetna Townsite, Plat No. 93-40 is consistent with AS 29.40.070 *Platting Regulations*, MSB 43.15.025 *Abbreviated Plats* and MSB 43.15.054(G) *Exemptions*. Plats to remove lot lines are exempt from provisions of the code, which require soils report submittals, legal and physical access, asbuilt survey, and topographic information. There were no objections received from borough departments, outside agencies or the public at the time of this staff report.

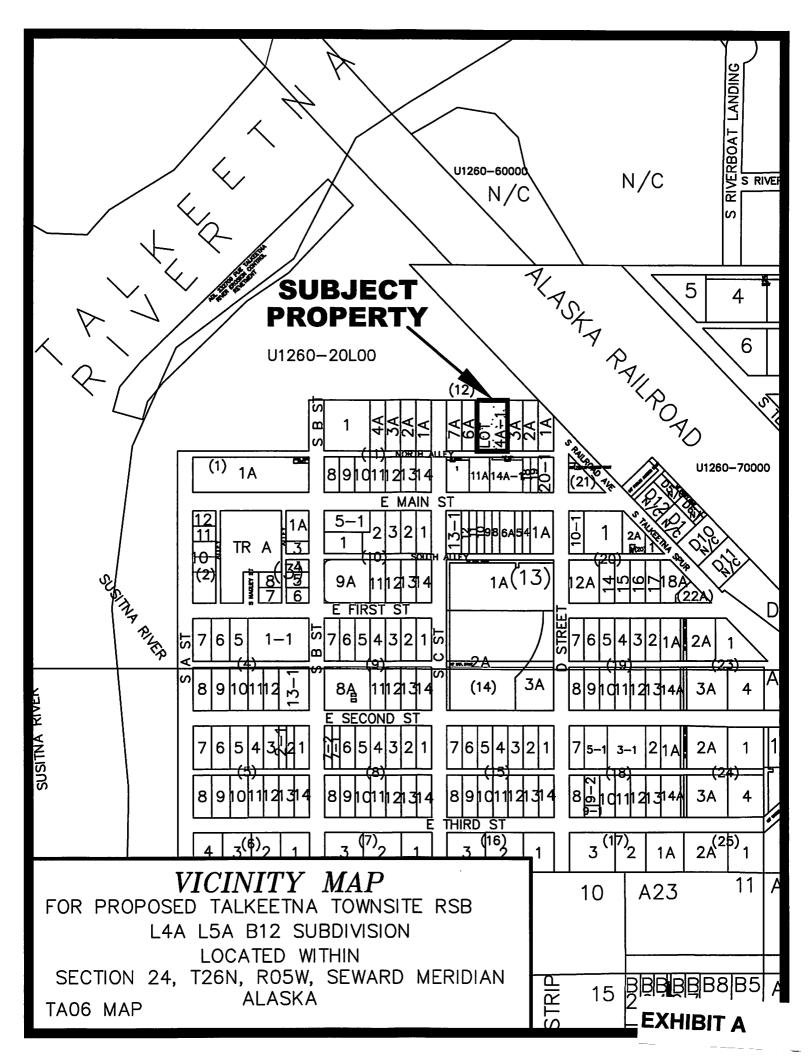

- 5. MSB 43.15.054(G) allows the surveyor to use record information from the recorded plat of Talkeetna Townsite, Plat No. 93-40, and does not require additional monumentation.

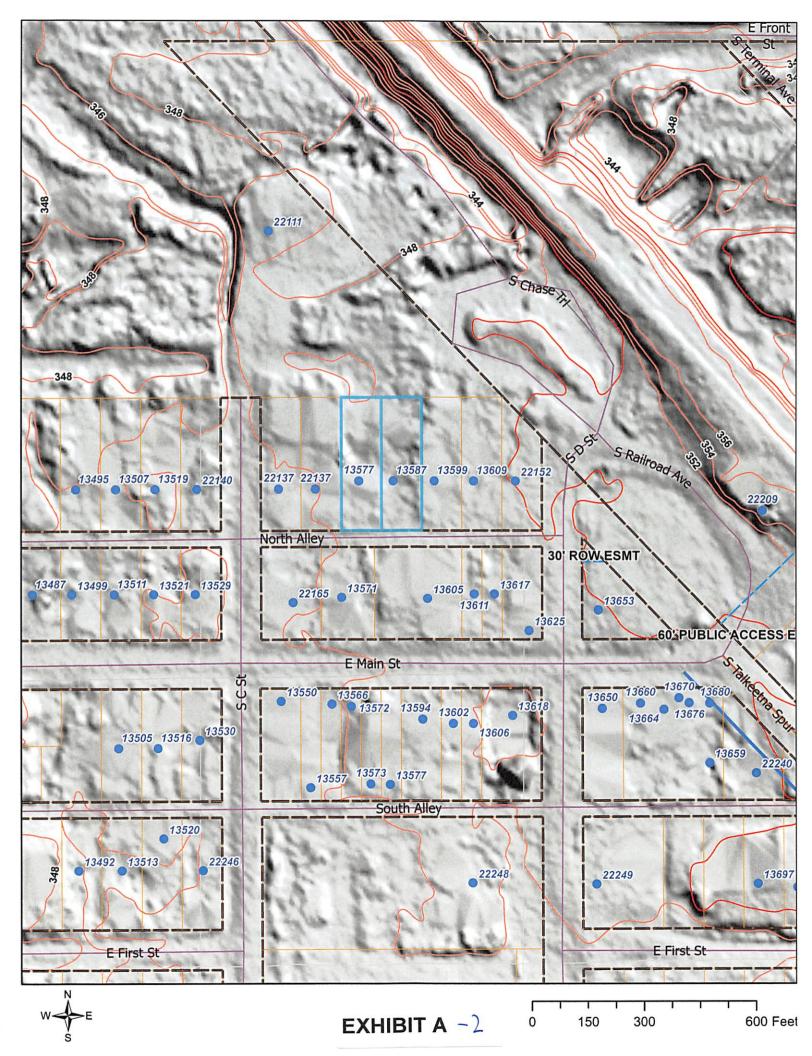

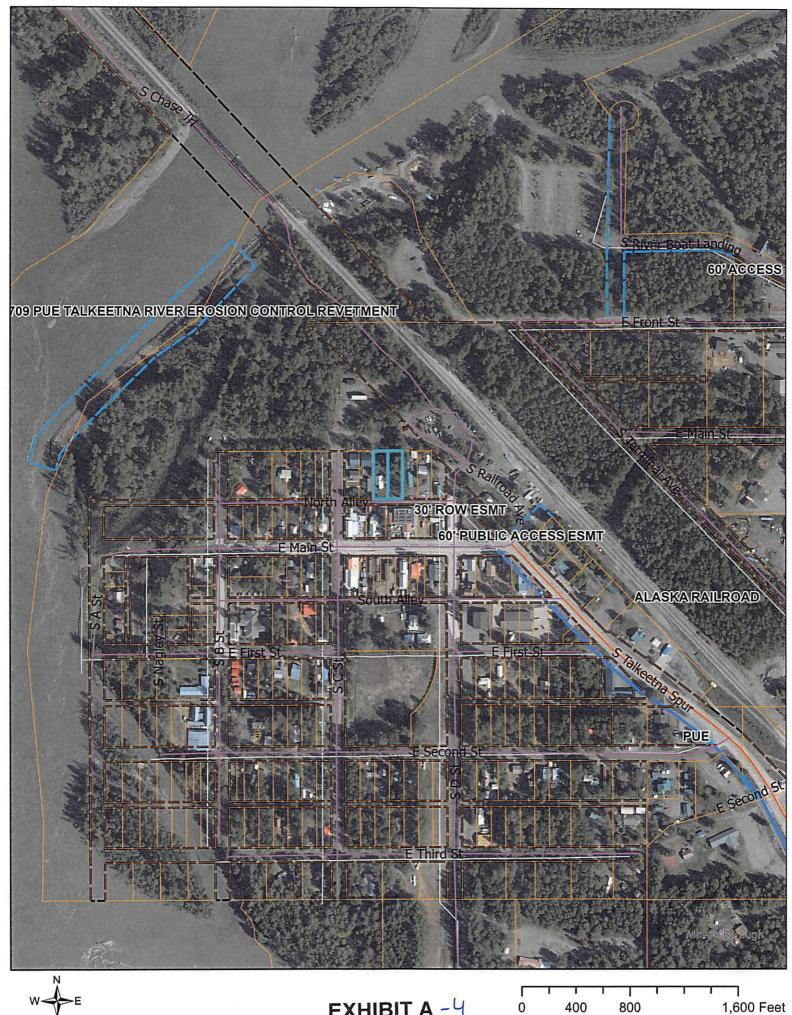

The Corps of Engineers (Corps) does not have any specific comments regarding Lot 4A-1 Block 12 Project.

Department of the Army authorization is required if anyone proposes to place dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S., including wetlands and/or perform work in navigable waters of the U.S.

A copy of the DA permit application can be found online at www.poa.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory. Sample drawings can also be found on our website at www.poa.usace.army.mil/Portals/34/docs/regulatory/guidetodrawings2012.pdf.

Section 404 of the Clean Water Act requires that a DA permit be obtained for the placement or discharge of dredged and/or fill material into waters of the U.S., including jurisdictional wetlands (33 U.S.C. 1344). The Corps defines wetlands as those areas that are inundated or saturated by surface or groundwater at a frequency and duration sufficient to support, and under normal circumstances do support, a prevalence of vegetation typically adapted for life in saturated soil conditions.

Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 requires that a DA permit be obtained for structures or work in or affecting navigable waters of the U.S. (33 U.S.C. 403). Section 10 waters are those waters subject to the ebb and flow of the tide shoreward to the mean high water mark, and/or other waters identified by the Alaska District. Aquaculture structures and work would require Section 10 Authorization.

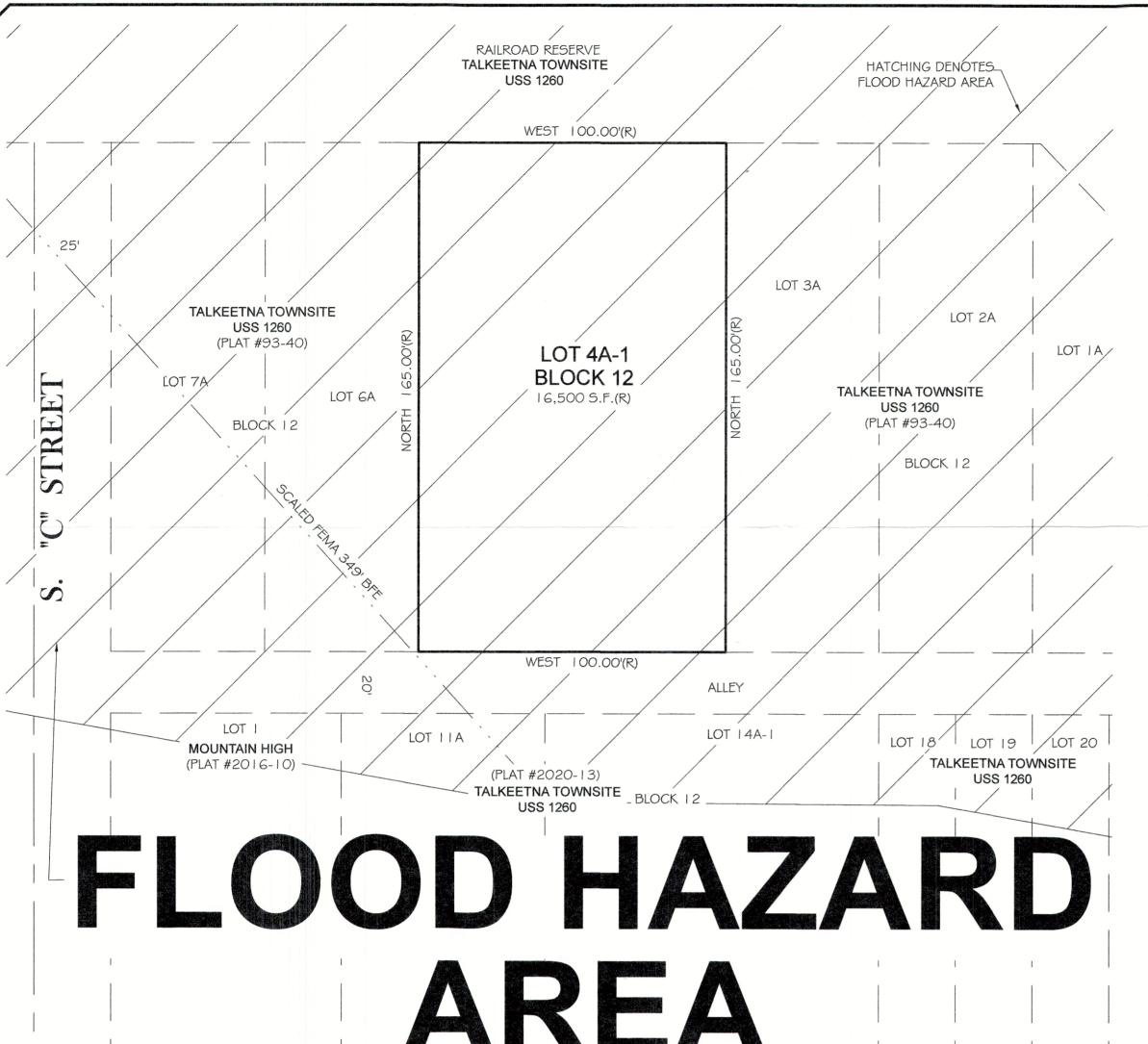
Creating one lot from Lots 4A & 5A Talkeetna Townsite will rectify a setback violation of one structure being over the existing lot line.

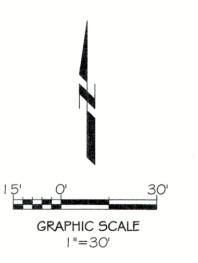

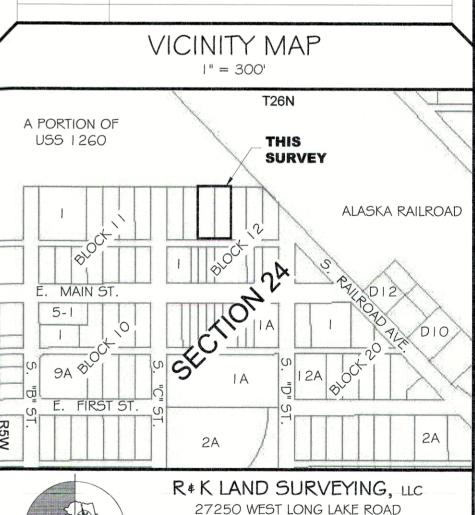

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The proposed subdivision is creating three lots from Lot 3, Block 4, Sutton Estates, Plat #72-34. Access for the proposed lots is from the N. Glenn Highway, an Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities maintained road.

Soils Report: A geotechnical report was submitted (**Exhibit B**), pursuant to MSB 43.20.281(A). Bill Klebesadel, PE, notes that two test holes were dug to a depth of 12'. Test hole locations are shown on the provided map. No groundwater was encountered in either test hole. All lots contain overall sufficient overall area. All lots have at least 10,000 square feet of useable building area. All lots have at least 10,000 square feet of contiguous usable septic area.

Sutton Estates 2025 2025-137 Page 1 of 4 10/22/2025 Topographic mapping and as-built information were provided and are at **exhibit** C. based on the supplied as-built information, no setback violations exist, nor will any be created by the recordation of the proposed Sutton Estates 2025 Subdivision.

Comments:

ADOT&PF (Exhibit D) has the following comments:

- Required to add a plat note: "Shared access for Lots 1, 2, & 3 to Glenn Highway." (Recommendation #4).
- Required to show shared access easement or dedicated road for consolidated access to the Glenn Highway (**Recommendation** #5).
- Access review exists as a separate process to platting. Coordinate with DOT&PF Right of Way for technical review of access to the Glenn Highway to determine permittable access location. Additionally, due to it's status as an interstate, access to the Glenn Highway requires concurrence from the Federal Highway Administration (FWHA). This will occur during the permitting process.
- Platting actions invalidate existing access permits. Apply for a new access permit to access the Glenn Highway. Driveway permits and Approach Road Review can be applied for at DOT&PF's online ePermits website: https://dot.alaska.gov/row/Login.po. Please contact DOT&PF's ROW division at 1-800-770-5263 to speak with a regional permit officer if you have any questions (Recommendation #6).

AKRR (**Exhibit E**) has the following comments:

- AKRR has no objection to the proposed subdivision.
- The lands depicted as Alaska Railroad Corporation on the agenda are Lot 1 of USS Survey 9077. Lot was conveyed by the United States to the Alaska Railroad Corporation with Patent 50-2010-0290 recorded in the Palmer Recording District as document #2010-011872-0. Please consider adding the label Lot 1 USS 9077 and the patent number.
- If the 2.5" Aluminum Post monument in Detail 1 is the monument for the Corner 2 Lot 1 of USS 9077 then consider my request for the surveyor to create a note regarding what monuments were held and why on the determination of the ARRC boundary. Consider recovering C1, L1 USS 9077 to defensibly locate the ARRC boundary.
- Consider removing the 200' denotation to the left of Alaska Railroad on the plat. While the ROW is nominally 200 feet, in this area it is defined by the Lot 1 of USS 9077 not exactly 200'. Platting staff notes that AKRR's concerns will be addressed as part of the final review process.

ADF&G (Exhibit F) has no objections to this subdivision request as it will not affect fish, wildlife, habitat, or public access to public lands and waters.

MSB DPW Pre-Design and Engineering Division (**Exhibit G**) recommends the subdivision share a single access point to the Glenn Highway. Continue to coordinate with ADOT&PF for access onto the Glenn Highway.

MSB Development Services (Exhibit H):

- Code Compliance has no objections to the proposed subdivision.
- Permit Center notes that this is a State Department of Transportation Right of Way, as such has no comments.

GCI has no comments or objections.

MTA has no comments due to this being an abbreviated Plat. MTA has an existing aerial cable where proposed Lot 2 will be. MTA will contact the property owner for an easement to cover these existing facilities.

MEA did not respond.

At the time of staff report write-up, there were no responses to the Request for Comments from DNR Division of M/L/W; USACE; Community Council #2 Sutton; Fire Service Area #4 Sutton; Road Service Area #31 Alpine; MSB Community Development, Emergency Services, Assessments, or Planning Division; or MEA.

CONCLUSION: The abbreviated plat of Sutton Estates 2025 is consistent with AS 29.40.070 Platting Regulations and MSB 43.15.025 Abbreviated Plats. There were no objections from any federal or state agencies, Borough departments, or utilities. There were no objections to the plat from the public in response to the Notice of Public Hearing. Legal and physical access exists to the proposed lots, consistent with MSB 43.20.100 Access Required, MSB 43.20.120 Legal Access and MSB 43.20.140 Physical Access. Frontage for the subdivision exists, pursuant to MSB 43.20.320 Frontage. A soils report was submitted, pursuant to MSB 43.20.281(A)(1).

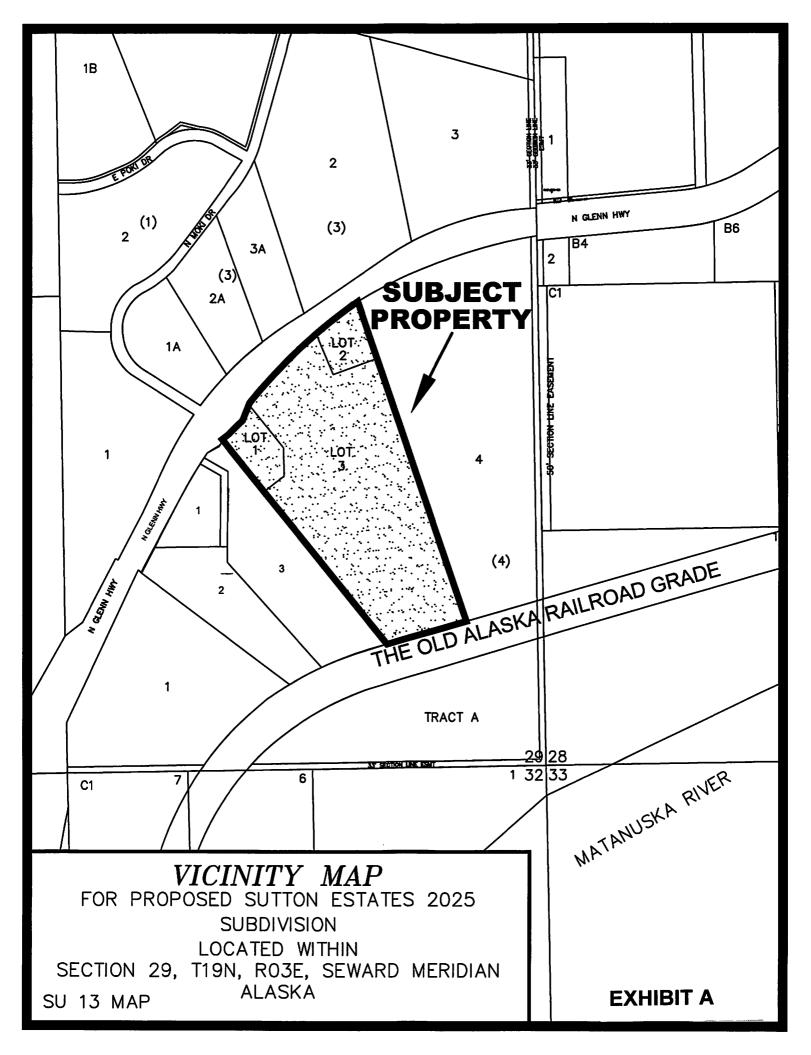

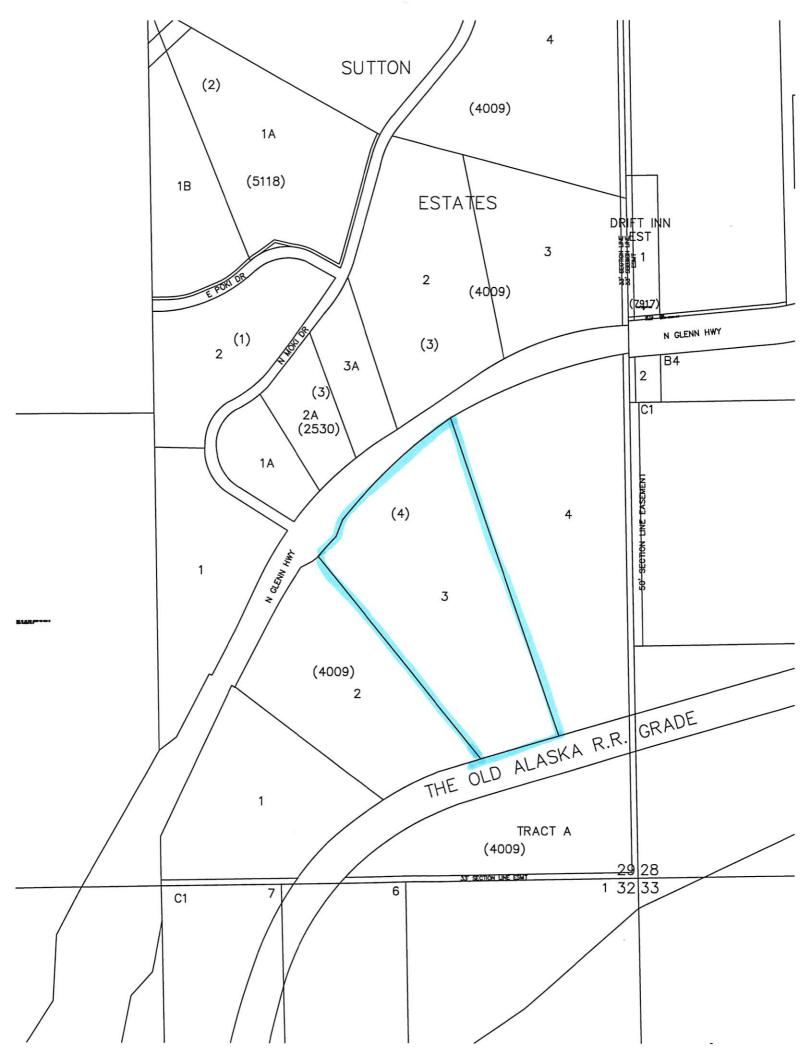

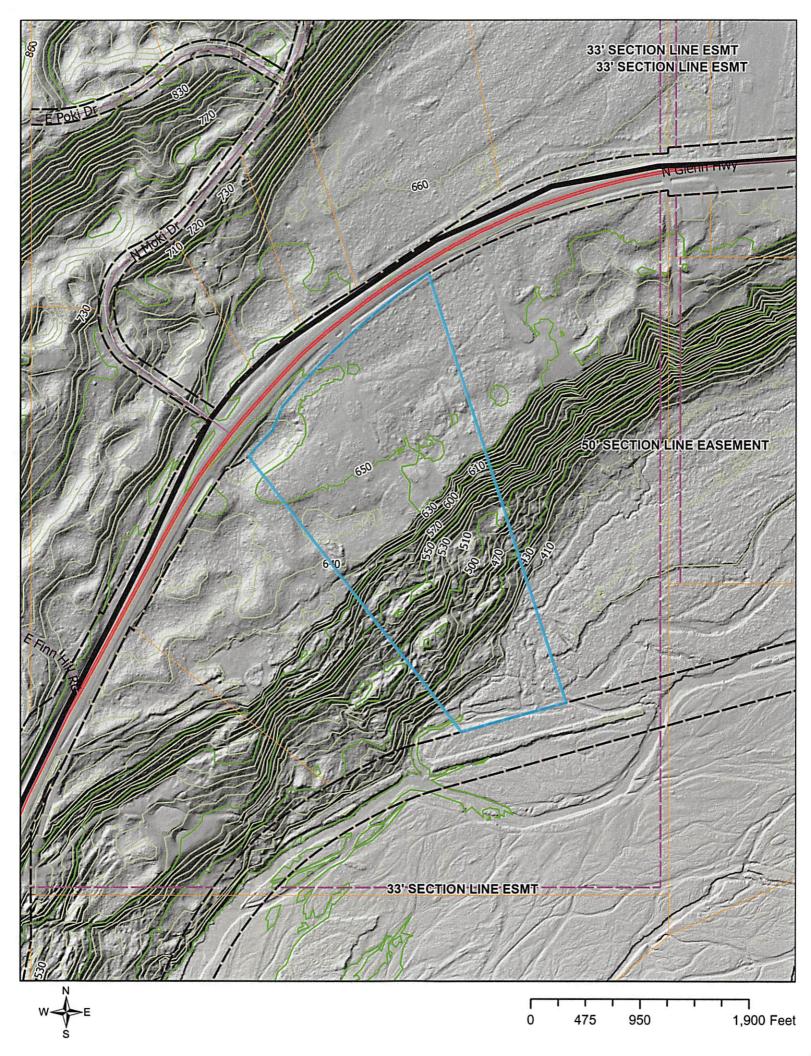

- 4. Add a plat note stating: All lots must share single access to the N. Glenn Highway unless otherwise authorized by the permitting authority.
- 5. Add a common access easement sufficient in size to allow all lots to share a common driveway access to the N. Glenn Highway.
- 6. Apply for a driveway permit and/or approach road review for the existing access to the N. Glenn Highway. Provide platting staff a copy of the accepted permit / permit application for any access to the N. Glenn Highway.
- 7. Show all easements of record on final plat.
- 8. Submit recording fees, payable to Department of Natural Resources (DNR).
- 9. Submit final plat in full compliance with Title 43.

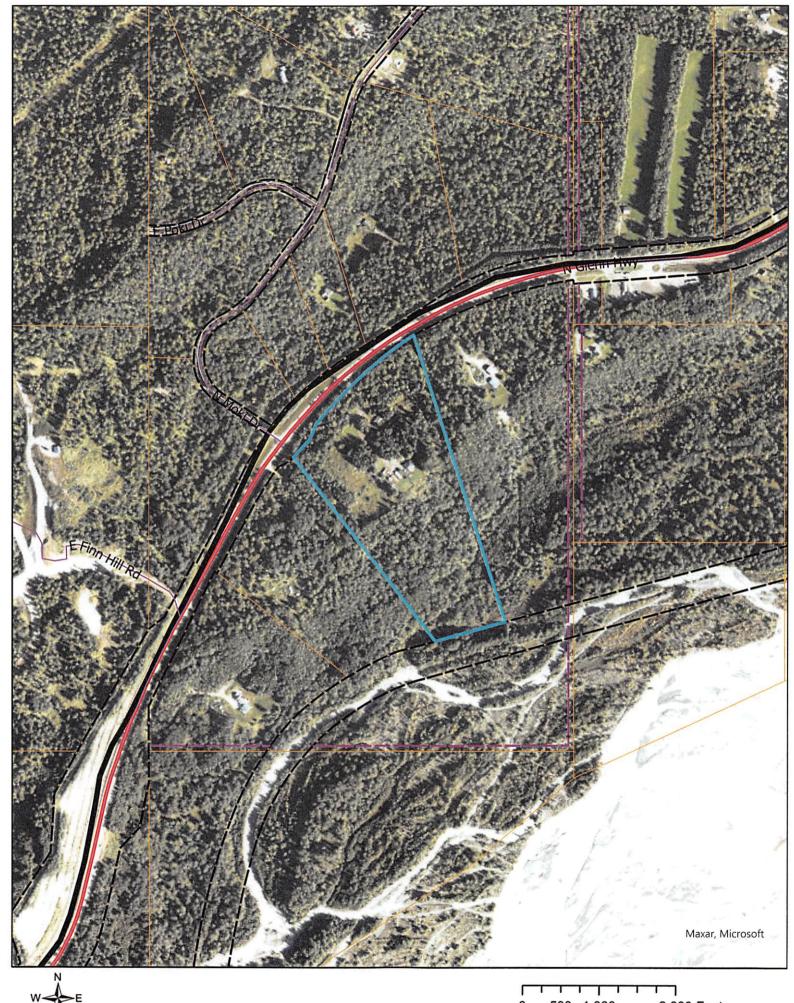

- The lands depicted as Alaska Railroad Corporation on the agenda are Lot 1 of USS Survey 9077. Lot was
 conveyed by the United States to the Alaska Railroad Corporation with Patent 50-2010-0290 recorded in the
 Palmer Recording District as Document Number 2010-011872-0. Please consider adding the label Lot 1 USS 9077
 and the patent number.
- If the 2.5" Aluminum Post monument in Detail 1 is the monument for the Corner 2 Lot 1 of USS 9077 then
 consider my request for the surveyor to create a note regarding what monuments were held and why on the
 determination of the ARRC boundary. Consider recovering C1, L1 USS 9077 to defensibly locate the ARRC
 boundary.
- Consider removing the 200' denotation to the left of Alaska Railroad on the plat. While the ROW is nominally 200 feet, in this area it is defined by the Lot 1 of USS 9077 not exactly 200'.

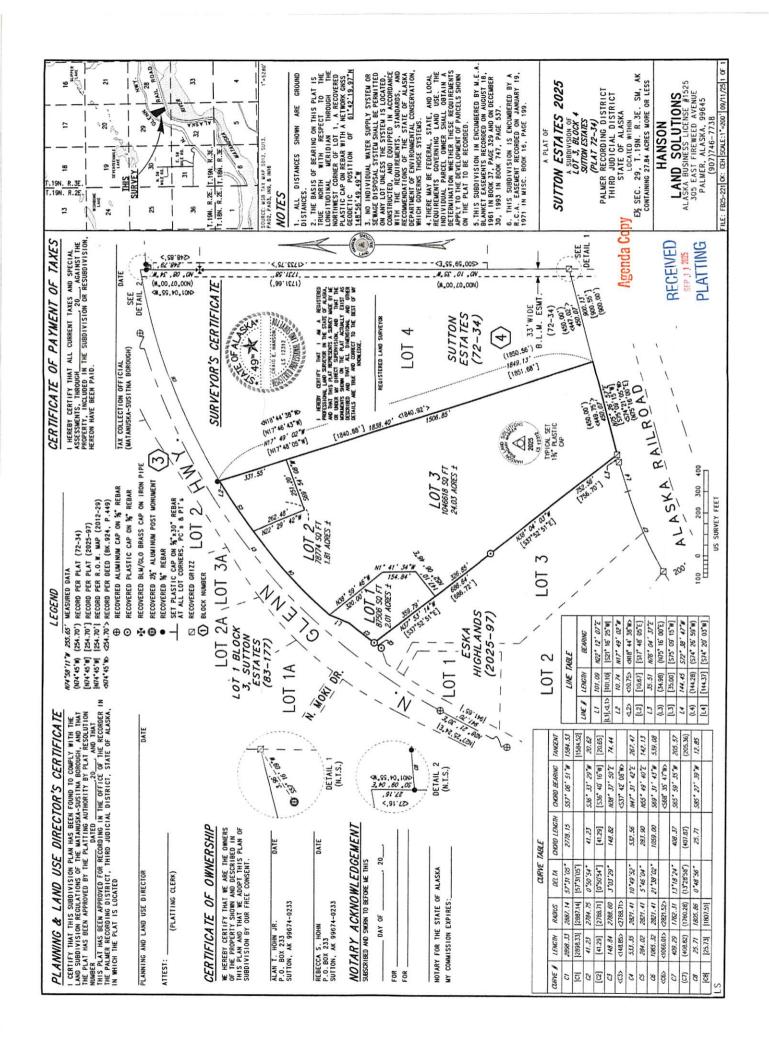

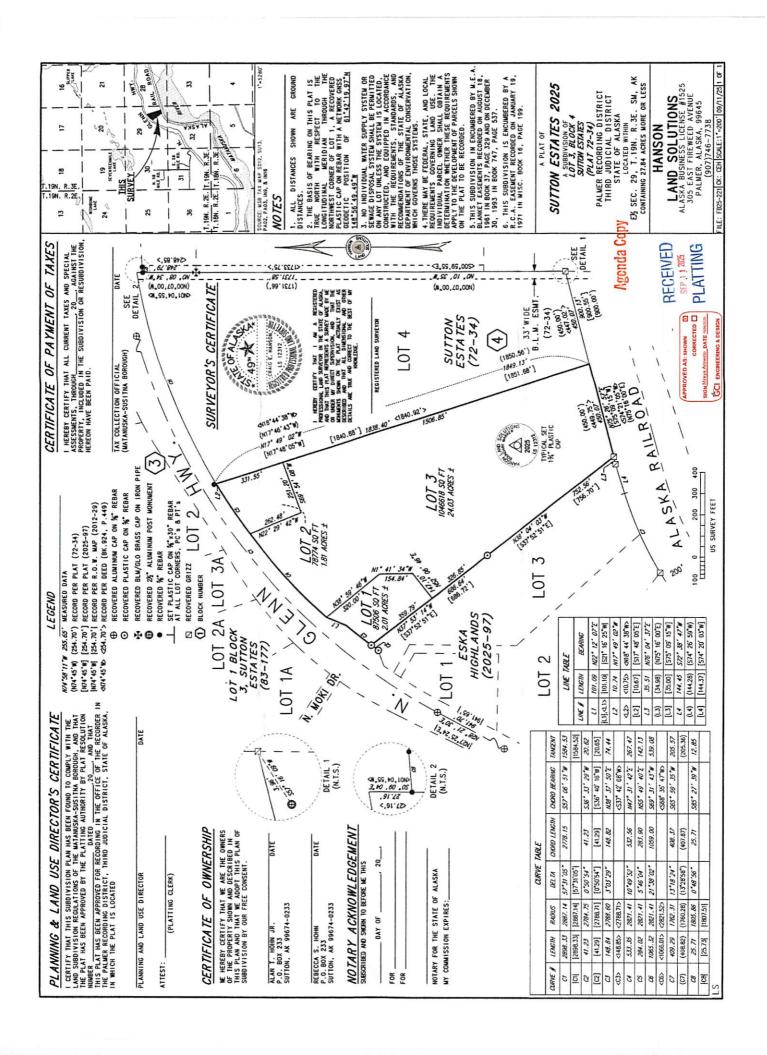

The request is to create one lot from Lots 7, 7A, and 8A Lucas RSB Subdivision, Plats 2022-92, 70-24 and to be known as LUCAS REPLAT 2025, containing 0.90 acres +/-. The plat is located south of W Fireweed Avenue, directly north of W Fern Avenue, and east of S Glenn Highway, located within the NE ¼ Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 02 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The subject parcels are located within the Lucas Subdivision. The proposed subdivision is heard under MSB 43.15.025, *Abbreviated Plats* and MSB 43.15.054(G), *Exemptions*. Elimination of common lot lines are exempt from survey and monumentation requirements and allows the surveyor to use record information from the prior plat.

COMMENTS:

There were no objections or concerns received from Borough departments, outside agencies or the public at the time of this staff report.

CONCLUSION

The plat of Lucas Subdivision, Block 2 is consistent with AS 29.40.070 *Platting Regulations*, MSB 43.15.025 *Abbreviated Plats* and MSB 43.15.054(G) *Exemptions*. Plats to remove lot lines are exempt from provisions of the code, which require soils report submittals, legal and physical access, as-built survey, and topographic information. There were no objections received from borough departments, outside agencies or the public at the time of this staff report.

FINDINGS of FACT:

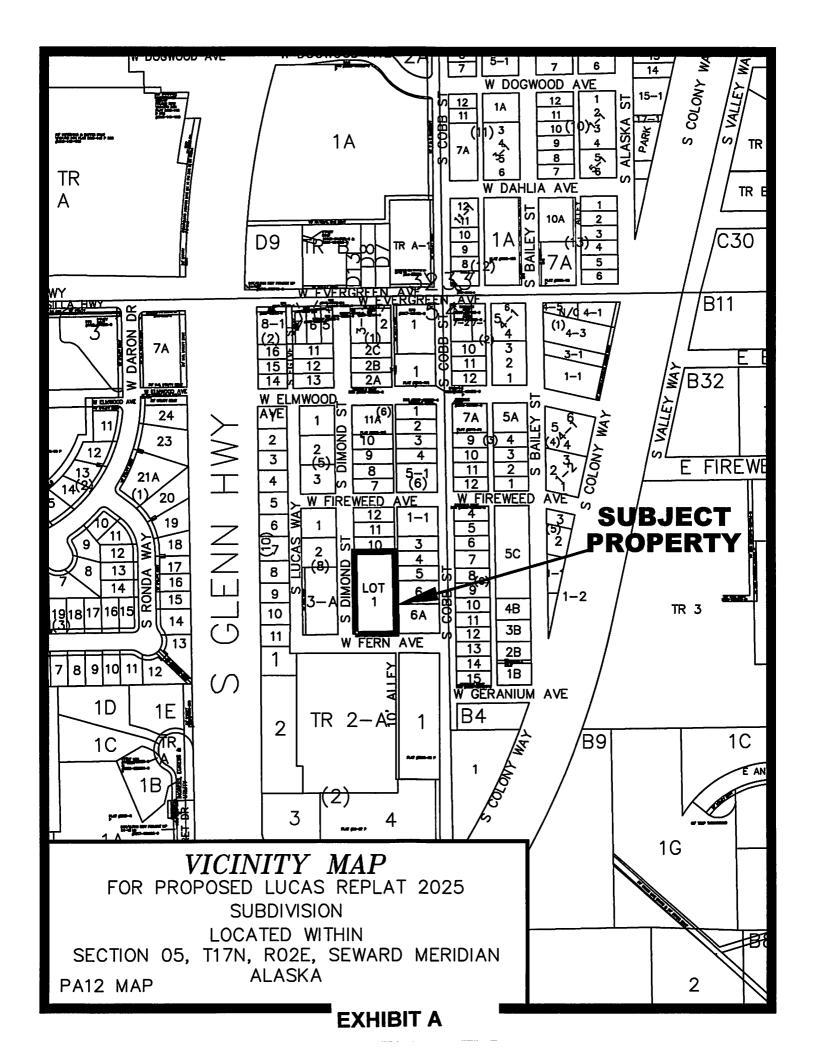
- 1. The abbreviated plat of Lucas 2025 is consistent with AS 29.40.070 *Platting Regulations*, MSB 43.15.025 *Abbreviated Plats*, and MSB 43.15.054(G) Exemptions.
- 2. This plat combines three lots within Lucas Subdivision, lessening the lot density in the area.

- 3. There were no objections from any borough departments, outside agencies or the public.
- 4. An elimination of common lot line plat is exempt from provisions of the code, which require soils report submittals, legal and physical access requirements, as-built survey or topographic information.
- 5. MSB 43.15.054(G) allows the surveyor to use record information from the recorded plat of Lucas Subdivision (Plat #70-24), and does not require additional monumentation.

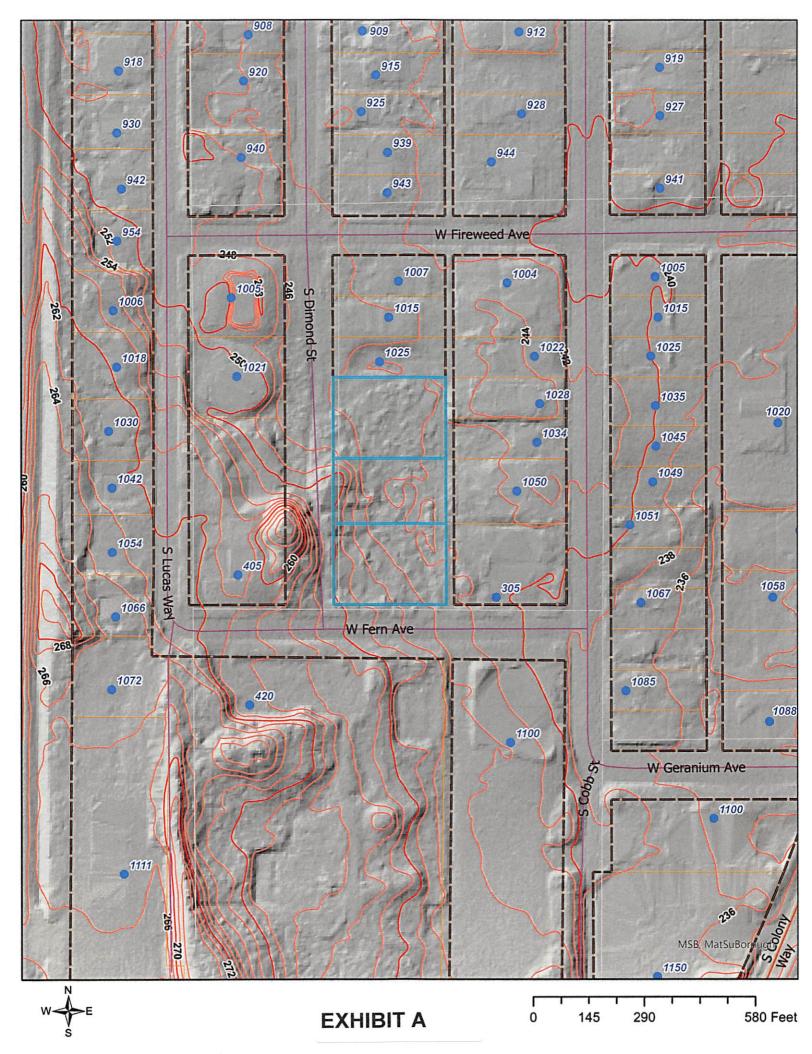
RECOMMENDED CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

Staff recommends approval of the abbreviated plat of Lucas 2025 contingent on the following recommendations:

- 4. Submit recording fee payable to DNR.
- 5. Submit final plat in full compliance with Title 43.
